Updates were submitted in 2021 for cadmium, cadmium oxide, cadmium hydroxide and further updates are planned in 2022.</p> <p>Follow ECHA Authorisation and Restriction procedures and respond to consultations and mobilise any identified advocacy on request of the General Assembly.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Current Restrictions on use of Cd and compounds are listed in Annex XVII, entry 23. - Cd & some Cd-salts are included in the “Candidate List” for potential inclusion in the Annex XIV List of substances subject to Authorisation.
