	MaREC has initiated to perform a series of tests regarding flammability of Mg Powders and Particulates which proofed that existing legal classification according DSD directive 67/548/EEC and CLP regulation (EC) 1272/2008 Annex VI does not match with the test results. To get clarification for classification and labelling a CLH-report has been prepared and launched via German CA BAuA to ECHA. The aim is to achieve a harmonised classification in future based on new scientific information according to CLP regulation (EC) 1272/2008, article 37. Although the CA refuses to start with the proposed procedure so far MaREC is still working on convincing them of the need for improvement.	
	A proposal for a new approach regarding "Harmonized Classification" by modification of CLP regulation (EC) 1272/2008 Annex VI will be placed on ECHA discussion forum for discussion amongst all co-registrants from SIEF in order to achieve agreement on "Harmonized Classification & Labelling".
