<b>Technical work</b>	Eleven substance technical dossiers completed and submitted by October 2010, and one in 2012.  First dossier updates: 2013. Second dossier updates: 2016. All dossiers are periodically reviewed and updated.
<b>Pre-existence of RA</b>	No comprehensive risk assessment existed for Mo
<b>Collection of data from DU</b>	MoCon DU Questionnaire circulated in 2008/9 – over 100 responses.
<b>Pre-registration</b>	Done. Membership treating FeMo alloys as preparation (i.e. will separately register Mo and Fe, to cover FeMo).
